2.0 Description of Entity

Treaty One Nation (T1N)

The Treaty One First Nations: Brokenhead Ojibway Nation, Long Plain First Nation, Peguis First Nation, Roseau River Anishinabe First Nation, Sagkeeng Anicinabe First Nation, Sandy Bay Ojibway First Nation, and Swan Lake First Nation, signed Treaty No. 1 in 1871.

Our mandate is to foster economic growth through strategic development on Treaty One lands by way of sustainable and innovative business ventures that generate revenue, prosperity, employment, skills, and development for the Treaty One Nations

Treaty 2 Anishinaabek Nation (T2-AN)

The Treaty 2 Anishinaabek Nation (T2-AN) is a collective government that is responsible for the protection, reclamation, and promotion of Anishinaabek Onakonegewin and Anishinaabe Agowidiwinan – Our Anishinaabek governance powers are granted by Gizhe Manitou to govern ourselves fully and rightfully.

Our sacred Miinagowiziiwin (Inherent rights) rightfully belong to the peoples of Treaty 2 Anishinaabek Territory.

Our 12 Member Nations are: Dauphin River, Keeseekoowenin, Lake Manitoba, Skownan, Gaagwekwekejiwang (Ebb and Flow), Lake St. Martin, Little Saskatchewan, O-Chi-Chak-Ko-Sipi, Pinaymootang First Nation, Gambler First Nation, Tootinaowaaziibing Treaty Reserve and Minegozibiing (Pine Creek First Nation). And our Nations serve in accordance with the highest honour to uphold the political and legal political orders of Anishinaabek Akii (21.4 M Square Miles).

3.0 Description of Work

T1N and T2-AN are hosting a large-scale event in need of security services. The Security Contractor will be responsible for providing all labour and management. The Contractor will also be responsible for operational costs, including supplies, materials, and maintenance of any equipment required to deliver security services at the event.

Appendix A:

- 24-hour services will be needed from July 24 at 4pm through July 31 at noon.
- The Contractor will be responsible for providing security services to 800-1000 people each day (July 25-30).
- A minimum of **2** security personal needed onsite at all times (includes overnight services).
- A minimum of **4** security personal during the following times July 28 3:30pm – 11:30pm, July 30 11:00 am – 6:00 pm.
- A minimum of **6** security personal during the following times July 29 11:00 am – 11:30pm.
