About The Treaties 1-11 Gathering

The Treaties 1-11 Gathering is an annual event which brings up to 1,200 leaders and community members together from numbered Treaty signatory First Nations across Canada. Leadership will discuss political, legal, International, and communications strategies. Other topics include Treaty framework, structure, lands, rights to health and education, paths to further healing from residential schools, promises made by the Crown; and what steps to follow in order to grow as sovereign Nations and leaders in the economic landscape.

It is a tremendous opportunity for the Treaty No. 1 and 2 Nations to be able to host the 2023 Treaties 1-11 Gathering, right here in the homeland of the first of 11 numbered Treaties signed between Canada and Turtle Island's First Peoples.

Sponsors can expect to engage Indigenous leadership from across Turtle Island and to strengthen business partnerships with the numerous Treaty 1-11 First Nations.





About Treaty One Nation

The Treaty One Nation is committed to the economic well-being of the signatory nations of Treaty No. 1, officially signed August 3, 1871: Brokenhead Ojibway Nation, Long Plain First Nation, Peguis First Nation, Roseau River Anishinabe First Nation, Sagkeeng First Nation, Sandy Bay Ojibway First Nation, and Swan Lake First Nation.

Our mandate is to foster economic growth through strategic development on Treaty One lands by way of sustainable and innovative business ventures that generate revenue, prosperity, employment, skills, and development for the Treaty One Nations.

Since our inception in 2018 we have hosted many successful events, including Anishinabe Days, where we saw hundreds of attendees and hosted a pow wow, Indigenous Market, a singing competition, and fireworks. In 2023 we will host our 3rd Annual Nation Challenge Golf Tournament, which helps raise funds for our Knowledge Keepers Council and Promise Keepers Youth Council, and the 152nd Anniversary Commemoration of Treaty No. 1's signing at Lower Fort Garry (the Stone Fort) will be celebrated on August 3rd, 2023.











About Treaty 2 Territory First Nations

The Treaty 2 Anishinaabek Nation (T2-AN) is a collective government that is responsible for the protection, reclamation, and promotion of Anishinaabek Onakonegewin and Anishinaabe Agowidiiwinan – Our Anishinaabek governance powers are granted by Gizhe Manitou to govern ourselves fully and rightfully.

Our sacred Miinagowiziiwin (Inherent rights) rightfully belong to the peoples of Treaty 2 Anishinaabek Territory.

Our 12 Member Nations are: Dauphin River, Keeseekoowenin, Lake Manitoba, Skownan, Gaagwekwekejiwang (Ebb and Flow), Lake St. Martin, Little Saskatchewan, O-Chi-Chak-Ko-Sipi, Pinaymootang First Nation, Gambler First Nation, Tootinaowaaziibing Treaty Reserve and Minegozibiing (Pine Creek First Nation). And our Nations serve in accordance with the highest honour to uphold the political and legal political orders of Anishinaabek Akii (21.4 M Square Miles).
