## Treaty One Joint Reserve Land Code Ratification Notice of Vote

**TAKE NOTICE** that a Ratification Vote shall be held in accordance with the Roseau River Anishinabe First Nation Community Ratification Process in order to determine if Eligible Voters approve the *Treaty One Joint Reserve Land Code* for Roseau River Anishinabe First Nation and the Individual Agreement. The *Land Code* and Individual Agreement shall be approved if a majority of participating Eligible Voters vote to approve them.




The Ratification Vote will include:

- 2. Mail-in-Voting from September 11, 2023 to October 11, 2023 (Ballots MUST BE received by OCT 11)
- 3. In-person Voting in Roseau River Anishinabe First Nation and Winnipeg

"DO YOU APPROVE THE TREATY ONE JOINT RESERVE LAND CODE FOR ROSEAU RIVER ANISHINABE FIRST NATION, DATED FOR REFERENCE AUGUST 8, 2022; AND THE INDIVIDUAL AGREEMENT WITH HIS MAJESTY THE KING IN RIGHT OF CANADA RESPECTING THE TREATY ONE JOINT RESERVE LAND?"
